CITY ROAD MAINTENANCE WORK

DOOR TO DOOR SALESMEN

The selling of goods, wares, and merchandise or soliciting orders requires a HEBER CITY BUSINESS LICENSE. No person shall operate a transient sales business without this license. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen to engage in transient sales. All applicants MUST be subjected to a background investigation and possess a valid



driver's license. Each person engaged in transient sales shall display their permit on their persons at all times when engaged in business for which a license is granted. If they DO NOT display their permit don't hesitate to notify the police.

IRRIGATION WATER

The anticipated dates for your irrigation water to end for 2013 are as follows:



Ditch Water: October 1, 2013.

Pressurized Irrigation: October 15, 2013.

METER READING

The last *summer* water meter reading will be done Monday, October 14, 2013. Please end all outdoor watering by this date. Water used between October 2013 and April 2014 is how the City determines what your sewer rate for the coming year will be.
