## HEBER CITY CITYWIDE ROAD MAINTAINENCE PROJECT

**NOTICE:** The City would like to make residents aware that it's general contractor, Staker Parsons and their subcontractors, will begin road maintenance work on many of Heber City's roads this summer starting in the May and continuing through September. This is part of the City's ongoing road maintenance program to patch, slurry, chip, and overlay various roads every 5 to 6 years throughout the City. These treatments seal and extend a road's useful life for a fraction of the cost of replacing roads if nothing were done.
