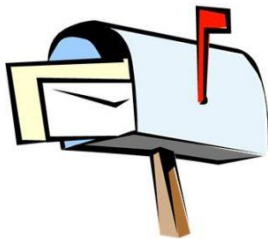

WATER BILL PAYMENT ADDRESS CHANGE

You may have noticed that your water payment's mailing address has changed to a PO Box in Pleasant Grove. This change applies to **bank bill-pay** and **mailed** payments only.

You may still make your water payment in person at the Heber City Treasurer's Office, dropping it in the payment drop box (located on the north side of the Heber City Office Building), paying online at xpressbillpay.com, or by calling 435-654-0757.

PRESSURIZED IRRIGATION WATER SHUT OFF NOTICE

Pressurized irrigation water is scheduled to be turned off during the second week of October. In the event of extreme cold weather, the irrigation water could be turned off sooner. If you are signed up for the Community Alerts service, you will receive an automated phone call, text, or email letting you know the projected date.

DRIVE-THRU FLU SHOT CLINIC

The Wasatch County Health Department has teamed up with Heber City to provide a drive-thru flu shot clinic on **October 11 from 2:30 to 6:30 pm** on the south side of the Heber City Public Safety Building, located at 301 S. Main Street. Come get your flu shot without ever having to get out of your car – just drive up, get your shot, and be on your way!

The health department has both the regular and high-dose flu shots available. Prices vary from \$37 for the regular

shot to \$66 for the high-dose. Acceptable forms of payment include cash, check, credit card, or a variety of insurance plans, including: Aetna, Altius Care Plans, DMBA, EMI Health, Medicare, Medicaid/CHIP/PCN, PEHP, SelectHealth, United Healthcare, and University of Utah (Premier only).

Health Department staff encourage those planning to get their flu shot at the drive-thru to wear a short-sleeve shirt or loose clothing that quickly bares the upper arm near the shoulder. For more information, contact the Health Department at (435) 657-3307.



GENERAL ELECTION NOVEMBER 5th



The 2019 General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 5th, 2019. The General Election will be conducted primarily by mail. Ballots will be mailed to registered voters on **October 16th**.

Completed ballots will need to be mailed and postmarked no later than the day **before** Election Day. Ballots may also be dropped off in person during Early Voting, on Election Day, or at the Wasatch County Clerk's office until 8:00 pm on Election Day.

Ballot Drop Box Locations

You may drop off your ballot inside the Wasatch County Clerk's Office located at 25 N. Main Street during the regular business hours of 8:00 am – 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

In Person Voting Locations and Hours

If you wish to vote in person using the touch-screen voting equipment, you may do so during Early Voting or on Election Day at the Wasatch County Clerk's Office located at 25 N. Main Street.

Early Voting will be offered during regular business hours of 8:00 am – 5:00 pm on October 29th, 30th, 31st, and November 1st.

Election Day Voting will be offered on November 5th from 7:00 am – 8:00 pm.

**Please bring photo identification if you wish to vote in person.*

STORM DRAIN FEE

You may have noticed your water bill now has a "Storm Drain Fee". **This is not a new fee.** In an effort to clear up any confusion, Heber City has simply renamed the previously known "Utility Fee" to a more concise term.
