
HEBER MARKET ON MAIN

UTILITY SERVICES PROVIDED TO THE GENERAL FUND

Annually the City provides the cost of Utility services provided to the General Fund. This is for informational purposes to be provided to the citizens. Per Section 10.6.135.5 of the Utah State Code: Notice is hereby given that the Heber City Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 15, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. to discuss unbilled services provided by the Water, Sewer and Utility Enterprise Funds to the Heber City General Fund. The estimated value of the services the General Fund receives are as follows: Water \$49,250, Pressurized Irrigation \$9,850, Sewer \$4,900 and Utility \$3,950. Interested citizens are invited to attend the hearing and express support or opposition to the proposed practice.
