DOG LICENSES



Just a reminder that every dog in Wasatch County is required to have a license, and **all** dog licenses expire December 31st and must be renewed each January. To obtain a license, please come to the Treasurer's Office, located in the Heber City Offices, 75 North Main Street. The fee is \$15.00 for spayed or neutered dogs and \$25.00 for unfixed dogs. Please bring proof of rabies shots.

PAY UTILITIES THROUGH AUTOPAY

Heber City Corporation offers Autopay as an option to paying your monthly utility bill. This program makes paying your bill easy, convenient, and will save you time and money by:

- Eliminating the need to write a check each month.
- Automatically deducting your utility payment from your account on the 19th of each month.
- Saving postage costs.
- Avoiding the need to make a special trip to the post office or to the city office to pay your bill.
- Making sure payments will be paid on time, no more late fees!
